

Flensburg Fjord Route Families with Children









This project is funded by the European Regional Development Fund

This is a supplement to the Flensburg Fjord Route cycling guide. In this leaflet you will find suggestions for excursions on the route which are particularly suitable for families with children, with selected attractions and suggestions for hotels which you can book yourself. All contact information appears in this leaflet.

Families with children – 7 days

Day 1 Arrival at Aabenraa and Aabenraa Citycamping, and exploration of the town. No cycling is planned on day 1, so there is plenty of time to experience Aabenraa and visit the **Museum of Cultural History Aabenraa**.

Day 2 Start the day on stage no. 1 to Nordborg – 44km in all. You will encounter **Varnæs Skovsø** (lake) en route, where you can park your bike and explore the area on foot. Get back in the saddle and head to Ballebro and catch the ferry to the island of Als – from where you cycle across Nordals to Nordborg, where you will be staying overnight at Nørherredhus Hotel.

Day 3 Stage no. 2 is 49 km long and ends in Sønderborg. You can visit **Universe Science Park** en route, where both children and adults can explore the world of science. Upon arriving at Sønderborg, you spend the night at Danhostel Sønderborg-Vollerup just outside the city.

Day 4 Today you'll be cycling on stage no. 3 from Sønderborg to Flensburg, a total distance of 64 km. We recommend that you stop at **History Centre Dybbøl Banke** to learn all about the historic battle of 1864. Stay overnight in Flensburg –you can find information under practical details.



Day 5 Today's trip runs on stage no. 4 to Langballigau – a short trip of 32 km. The route takes you to Volkspark, where you can take a break and enjoy the park's playgrounds or green areas. Heading onwards to Langballigau, you will come to Glücksburg, where you can visit the castle at Glücksburg Castle and the Klimapark Glücksburg. The day ends with overnight accommodation in Langballigau – where you can find your preferred place to stay at www.flensburger-foerde.de/en.

Day 6 Stage no. 5 has a length of 46 km and runs from Langballigau back to Flensburg. We stop en route at **Lands-chaftsmuseum Angeln** open-air museum in Unewatt. If you need another stop en route, or you wish to explore another area, the archaeological site at **Arnkiel-Park** is worth a visit. Once again, you spend the night in Flensburg.

Day 7 The 49-km leg runs from Flensburg to Aabenraa. Back in Denmark, you cycle through Padborg and past **Museum Oldemorstoft**, which is worth a visit. This leg concludes in Aabenraa with a visit to the reunification park, **Genforeningsparken** and the steps, **Formidlingstrappen**, in connection with the park, before you once again spend the night at Aabenraa Citycamping.

Families with children - 3 days, no. 1

This route is only possible when the Rødsandcycle ferryis in service, 26 June–15 August.

Day 1 Start the day in Flensburg with a visit to the shipping museum at **Flensburger Schifffartsmuseum** and the historic harbour. You will be staying overnight in Flensburg at a venue of your choice, which can be found on Flensburg Fjord's website.

Day 2 The trip today takes in stage no. 4 to Langballigau – a short trip of 32 km. The route takes you to **Volkspark**, where you can take a break and enjoy the park's playgrounds or green areas. Heading onwards to Langballigau, you will come to Glücksburg, where you can visit the **Glücksburg Castle** and the **Klimapark Glücksburg**. The day ends with overnight accommodation in Langballigau - where once again you can find your preferred place to stay at www.flensburger-foerde.de/en.

Day 3 In the morning you take the Rødsand cycle ferry from Langballigau to Brunsnæs, after which you continue on stage no.5 (or at least part of it) for another 37 km before arriving back in Flensburg. There is time for a visit to the former brickworks at **Cathrinesminde Brickworks** en route.



Families with children - 3 days, no. 2

No round-trip—different start and finish.

Day 1 This trip begins in Nordborg with stage no. 2 of 49 km and ends in Sønderborg. You can visit **Universe Science Park** en route, where there is plenty of opportunity for both children and adults to explore the world of science. On arriving in Sønderborg, you spend the night at Danhostel Sønderborg-Vollerup just outside the city.

Day 2 Today you cycle on a part of stage no. 3 from Sønderborg to Rinkenæs, a total of around 32 km. We recommend a visit to **History Centre Dybbøl Banke** and the former brickworks at **Cathrinesminde Brickworks** en route. You stay overnight at Danhostel Flensborg Fjord.

Day 3 On day 3 you complete the last part of stage no. 3 to Flensburg, approx. 20 km. You cycle along Fjordvejen, where you can make a stop in Sønderhav to enjoy the view of the islands of **Oksegerne** and eat an ice-cream at Annie's Kiosk. You cross the border to Germany at the minor border crossing at Skomagerhus, before embarking on the final few kilometres to the city of Flensburg. In Flensburg there is plenty of time to explore the city and the historic harbour, e.g. with a visit to the maritime museum at **Flensburger Schifffartsmuseum**, before heading to your hotel for the night, which you can find on Flensburg Fjord's website.
