This is a supplement to the Flensburg Fjord Route cycling guide. In this leaflet you will find suggestions for places to stay and attractions on the route for those that have a particular interest in flowers and gardens. You can book places to stay overnight and any attractions yourself. All contact information appears in this leaflet.

Flowers and Gardens - 7 days

Day 1 Arrival at Hotel Sønderborg Strand. No cycling is planned on day 1, so there is plenty of time to experience the city of **Sønderborg**.

Day 2 Today you cycle on stage no. 3 from Sønderborg to Flensburg, a total of 64 km. We recommend a visit to **Gråsten Palace Gardens** and the **Royal Kitchen Garden** en route. Overnight accommodation is in Flensburg – find contact information under Overnight Accommodation.

Day 3 The day's trip runs on stage no. 4 to Langballigau – a short trip of 32 km. The route takes you to **Volkspark**, where you can take a break and enjoy the park. Heading onwards to Langballigau, you will come to Glücksburg, where you find the rose gardens at the **Rosarium**. The day ends with overnight accommodation in Langballigau – where, once again, you can find your preferred place to stay at www.flensburger-foerde.de/en.



Day 4 Stage no. 5 is 46 km long and runs from Langballigau back to Flensburg. In Flensburg there is plenty of time to visit the park at **Christiansen Gärten** and the historic harbour, where you also find the **Erzählgarten Flensburg** (part of the Blumen Bauen Brücken project). Once again, you spend the night in Flensburg.

Day 5 The 49-km leg runs from Flensburg to Aabenraa. This leg concludes in Aabenraa with a visit to the reunification park, **Genforeningsparken**, and the steps, **Formidlings-trappen** (also part of the Blumen Baen Brücken project), in connection with the park. You can spend the night at Hotel Europa.

Day 6 Start the day with a stroll through the gardens of **Postmestergårdens Have**, after which you cycle on stage no. 1 to Nordborg – some 44 km in all. Here, you stay the night at Nørherredhus Hotel.

Day 7 This trip's final leg, stage no. 2, is 49 km long and ends up back in Sønderborg. On the trip you can stop by **Universe Science Park**, where you can visit the garden at **Bitten's Garden**. Once back in Sønderborg, you spend a final night at Hotel Sønderborg Strand.

Flowers and Gardens - 3 days

This route is only possible when the Rødsand cycle ferry is in service, 26 June–15 August.

Day 1 Start the day in Flensburg at **Christiansen Gärten** and the harbour, where you also find the **Erzählgarten Flensburg** (part of the Blumen Bauen Brücken project). You spend the night in Flensburg at the accommodation of your choice. Contact information appears under Overnight Accommodation.

Day 2 The day's trip runs on stage no. 4 to Langballigau – a short trip of 32 km. The route takes you to **Volkspark**, where you can take a break and enjoy the park. Heading onwards to Langballigau, you will come to Glücksburg, where you find the rose gardens at **Rosarium**. The day ends with overnight accommodation in Langballigau – contact information under Overnight Accommodation.

Day 3 In the morning you take the Rødsand cycle ferry from Langballigau to Brunsnæs, after which you continue on stage no. 5 (or at least part of it) for another 37 km before you arrive back at Flensburg. There is time for a brief diversion to Gråsten, where you can visit **Gråsten Palace Gardens** and the **Royal Kitchen Garden**.
